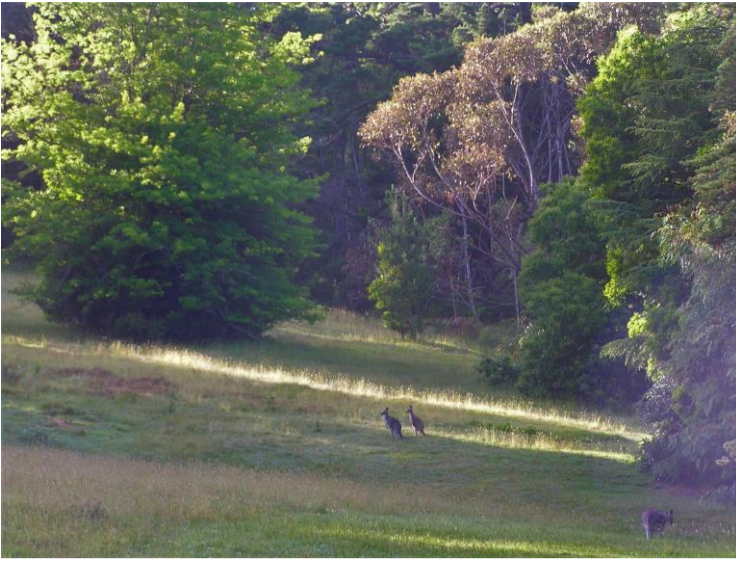


Supplementary evidence of adequate Melbourne water reserves.

Observations early on 7/Dec/2016 in Maroondah Reservoir Park



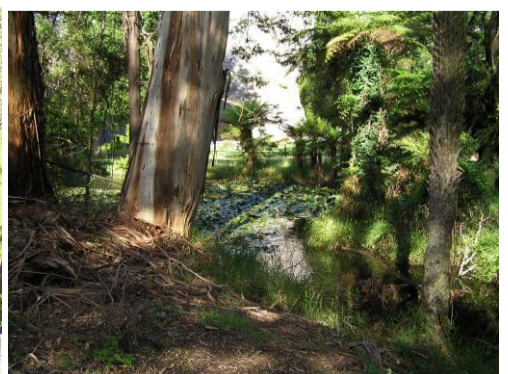
Healthy grassland about 500m from the Dam wall Magnificent cork tree metres from dam wall



~10 metres left of cork tree (Empirical evidence that the dam was full at ~8:00 am on 7/Dec/2016 = no bare earth visible)



From further along the dam wall, more empirical evidence.



Proof of existence of a dam wall: a) the wet side, b) zooming in below on the mostly dry side and c) looking back at the dam wall, seen as white background from behind b).

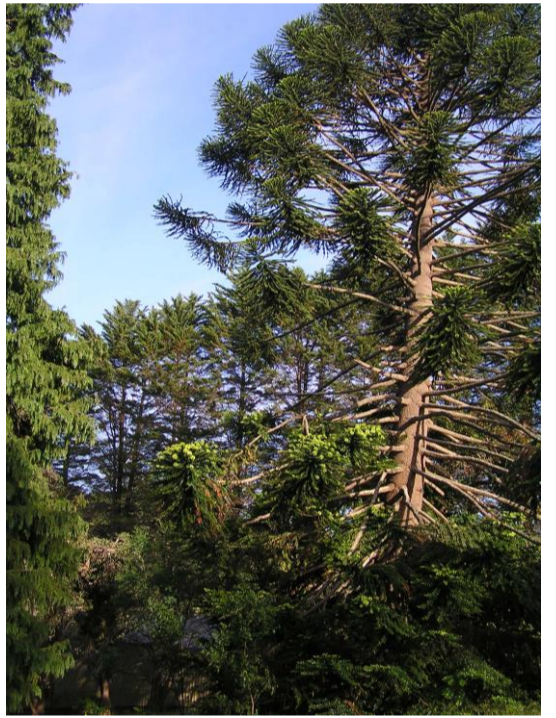
